

Exam Day: Reminder to Exam Candidates

Candidates are reminded to comply with all exam regulations (stated in the Attendance Notice) and invigilator instructions on the day of the examination. Non-compliance is considered a misconduct which will result in disciplinary action.

Candidates must pay attention to, listen to and follow the instructions of the invigilators on examination day. Claims by candidates that they were not able to hear the announcements on the regulations will not be accepted as an excuse for violations of regulations or instructions.

In the excitement of sitting for the examination, candidates may be less attentive to the announcements read by the Chief Invigilator. Therefore, for candidates' convenience, with effect from 2010, examination regulations and instructions will be printed on the OMR form or answer book cover so that they will be available to candidates at all times during the exam. Candidates will be required to sign off on the OMR form or answer book cover to acknowledge that they have read and agree to comply with the examination regulations and instructions.
